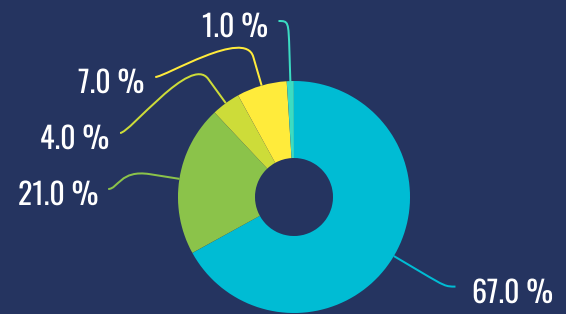

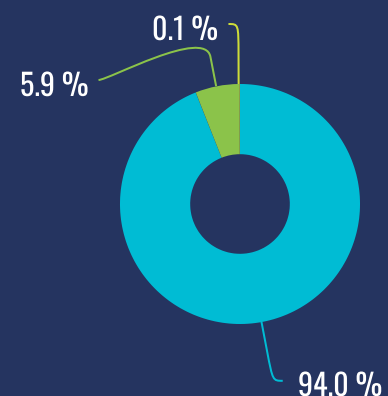
Financials Performance*

Total Revenue: \$1,277,648.12



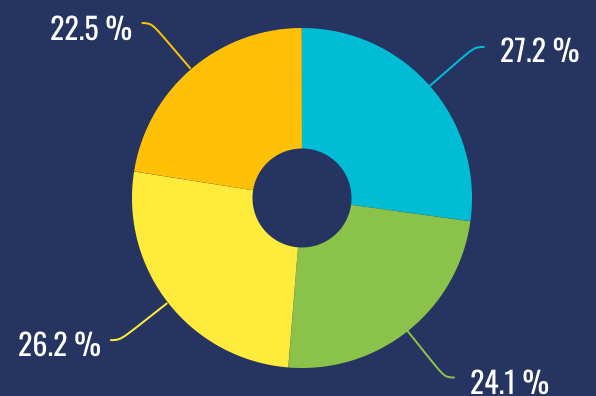
