2024 Highlights

Housing Fairs

In 2024, we launched two Housing Fairs in Charleston and Huntington, serving over 600 people to raise awareness of housing programs and services. These efforts were aimed at fostering the creation of generational wealth through homeownership.



Huntington Expansion

We achieved a significant milestone with the successful launch of our Huntington office, expanding our reach and impact. We also added a new position, Home Development Coordinator, to our team. This role further strengthened our organizational capacity, enabling us to apply for over \$13 million in funding for affordable housing projects. The new office has enhanced housing counseling services and increased affordable housing options in Cabell and Wayne Counties, ensuring greater access to resources and opportunities for the community.

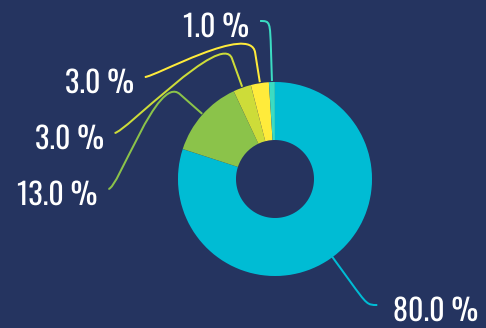

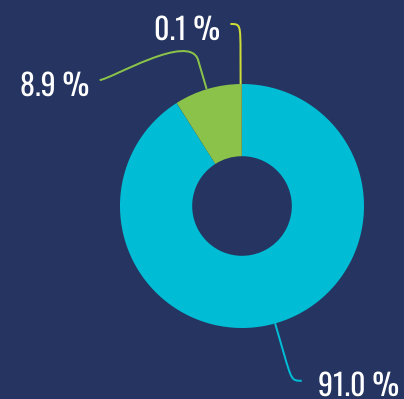

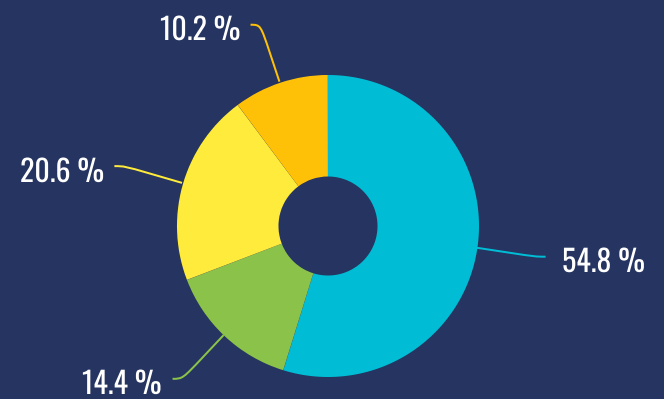
